

Aysén Histórico

On this excursion you will live the experience of going through part of the history of this beautiful region.

Itinerary: (Full day 10 ~ 11 hours)

We will leave at 09:00 am from the Hotel Loberías del Sur, just outside, next to the hotel, is the monument to Enrique Simpson, Captain of the corvette Chacabuco in the years 1870 and 1874, who explored the archipelagos of the Guaitecas and Chonos and entered the Aysén River making the first maps. He is considered one of the most important explorers of the Aysén region, leading the first 3 expeditions of the Chilean Navy carried out between 1870 and 1874, in which he managed to unite the Pacific Ocean with the Patagonian waters of the area.

We will continue the road to Puerto Aysén, located on the banks of the Aysén River and which was the first Regional Capital and main port of the region. We will cross the iconic suspension bridge, Puente Presidente Ibáñez, inaugurated in 1966, which crosses the Aysén River and was named a national monument in 2002. Then we will walk along the waterfront and visit the Plaza de Armas. We will continue our journey to Bahía Acantilada, the southernmost authorized beach resort in Chile. Here we will enjoy a coffee looking at the beautiful landscape that this place offers us and where the Aysén fjord begins, an old route where sailors navigated in remote times.

Our journey continues along the banks of the Simpson River to Lake Elizalde. Here we have the opportunity to have lunch in a very beautiful natural setting. Once we finish lunch, we will continue to the City of Coyhaique, capital of the region since 1974. Here we will visit the regional museum of Aysén, which won the Berlin "Leading Culture Destinations" award as the best new museum in the Latin American category 2022, this recognition is for the work of protecting and disseminating the heritage that identifies this southern region.

You will also be able to see the main square of this city, the curiosity that is pentagonal, in which 10 streets lead, being different from all other main squares of Chile.

We will return to the road to Puerto Chacabuco to arrive at the hotel at approximately 7:30 p.m.
